Guest Speaker: Dermot Finch

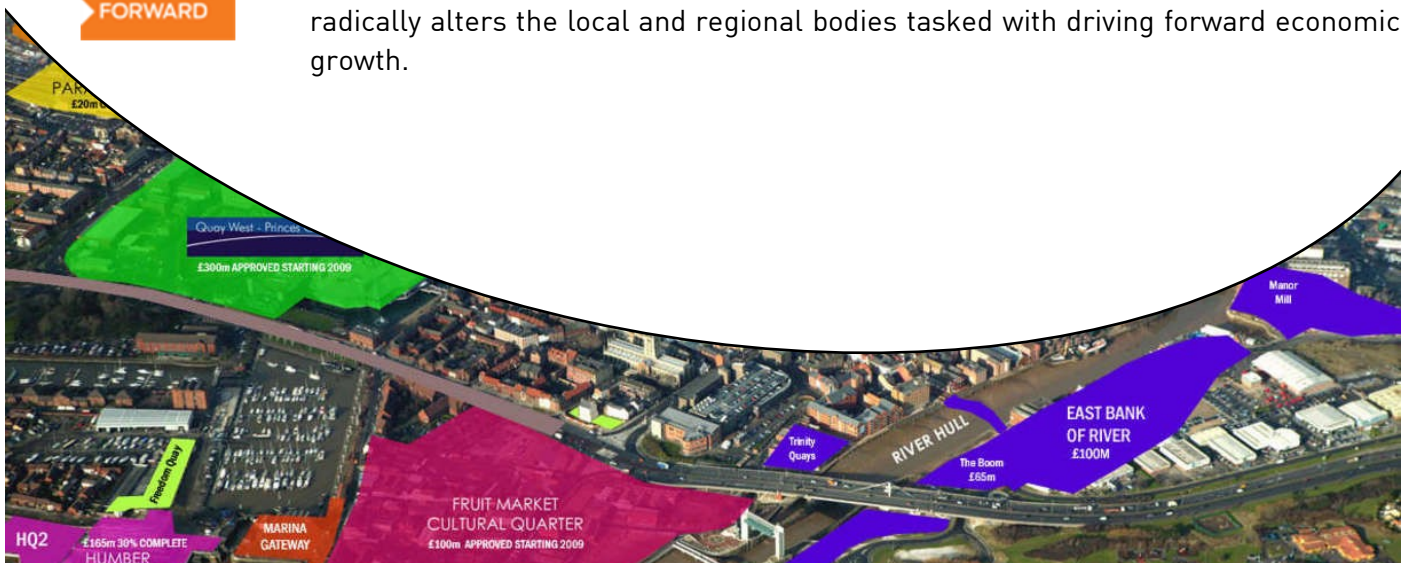

He is now recognised as one of the key influencers on Government policy on cities and business.
