Entrepreneurs call for tax breaks to help drive enterprise



In a survey of the top entrepreneurial business leaders, more than half of the finalists polled from the UK's Entrepreneur Of The Year, rated reform of tax rates or the scrapping of the 50p rate, as the key measure to help entrepreneurs.

The business leaders, most of whom have started businesses from scratch, and now employ thousands of workers across the UK, described the 50p tax rate as an obstacle to enterprise and incentive. Others

complained that they had lost senior managers abroad due to the current rates, severely damaging the expansion of their company.
